

NOTICE OF HERBICIDE APPLICATION

Monday, September 14, 2020

Ark Ecological Services will conduct an herbicide application at Roxborough Village and in Chatfield Farms on Monday, September 14, 2020, weather permitting.

We will be applying Transline (Signal Word: Caution), possibly Telar (Signal Word: Caution), QuinStar (Signal Word: Caution), and Weedar (Signal Word: Danger) on broadleaf weeds in areas where there may be woody vegetation. Milestone (Signal Word: Caution), Telar (Signal Word: Caution), and Weedar (Signal Word: Danger) would be key herbicides that may be used in the riparian corridor adjacent to streams. Open areas without woody vegetation that has Bindweed or Leafy Spurge may be sprayed with Method (Signal Word: Caution), Weedar (Signal Word: Danger) and possibly other tank partners. Visita (Signal Word: Warning) combined with other tank partners will be used on roadside or tailside Kochia.

Herbicides will be marked with a blue dye or yellow dye. Yellow "Pesticide Warning" flags will be posted at major entrances into the open space, along trails, and at key locations to let adjacent property owners and others know about the herbicide applications. Flags have the date sprayed, the herbicides sprayed, and the signal word posted on the back of the flag. Please stay out of sprayed areas until dry - usually about 15 -30 minutes.
