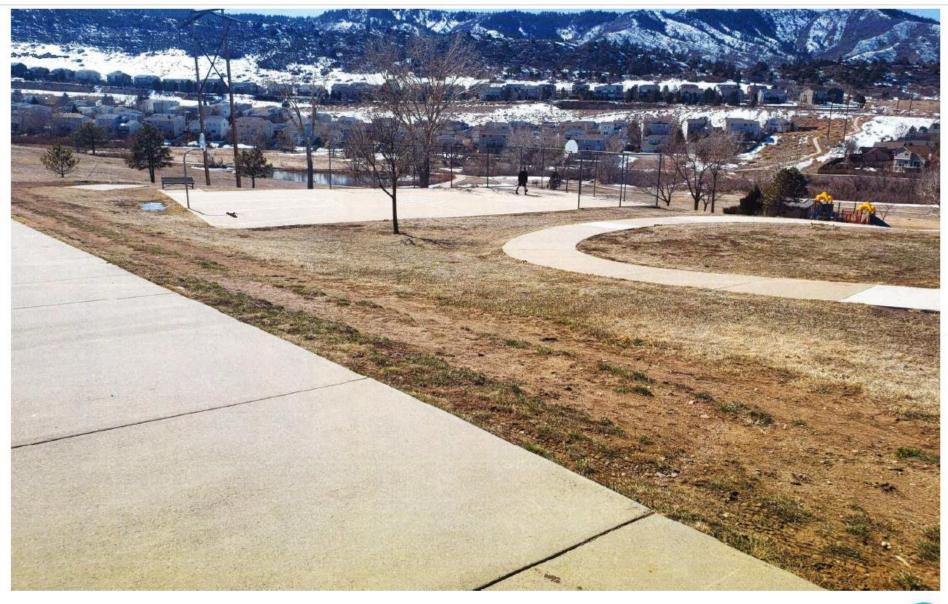

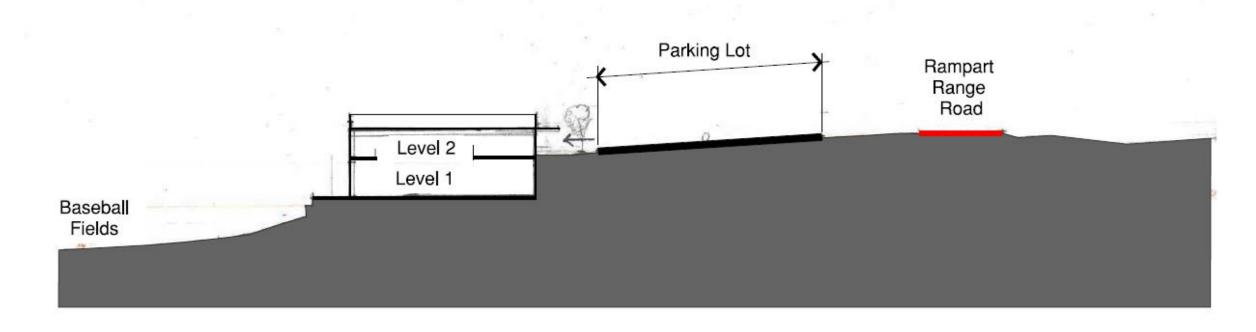




Site Access / Parking Expansion



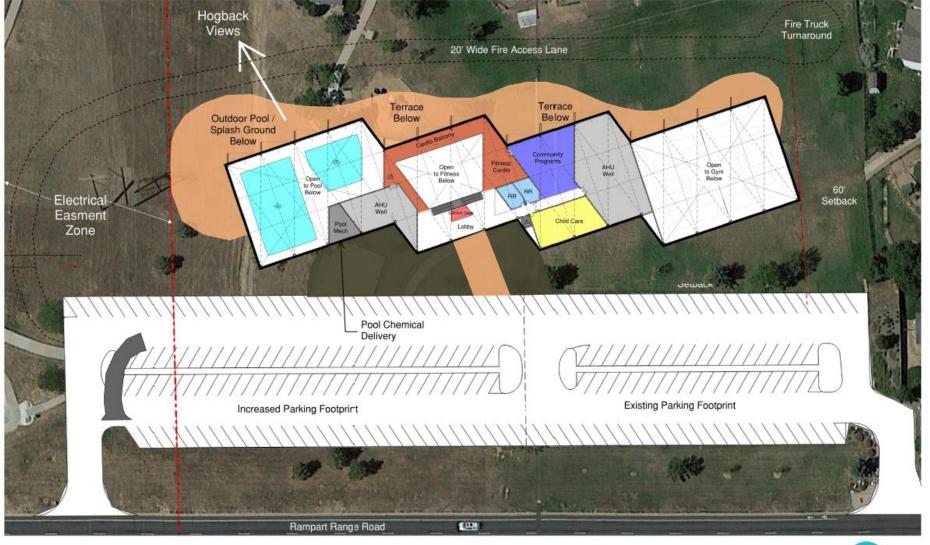

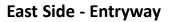

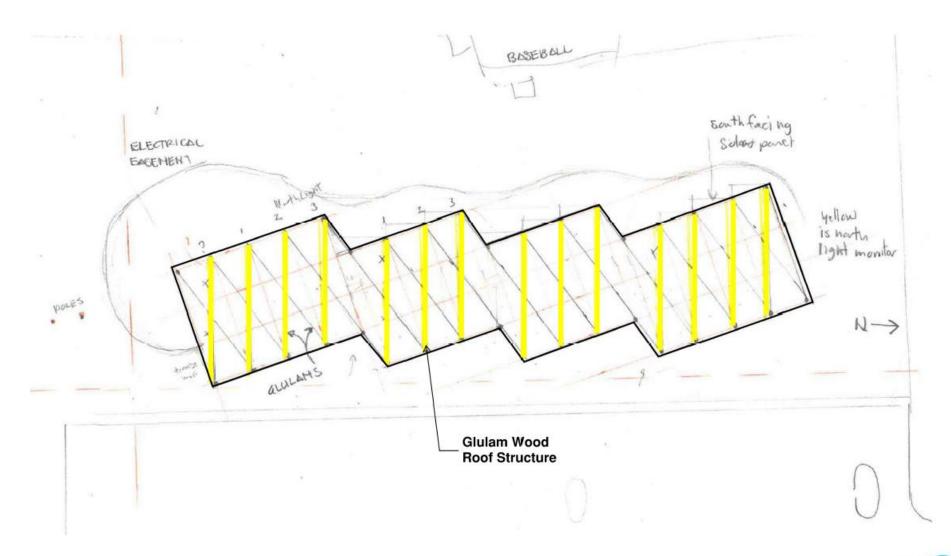

Roof Construction Concept

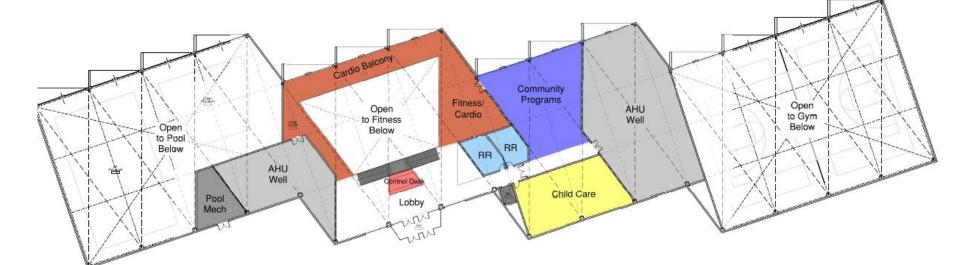

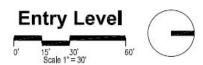

Entry level diagram

-upper floor, with entry way off of the current surface parking lot area -entry level includes community program space, child care, cardio and fitness balcony, lobby/entry desk -descend to gym, pool, additional fitness and community spaces -AHU = air-handling unit (inside building, not on the roof)

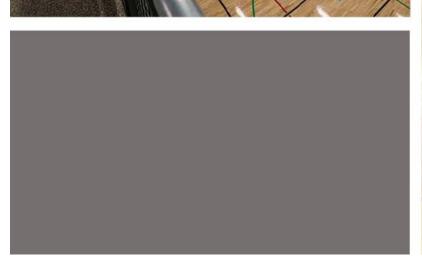
-comfortable waiting, reception, small group meeting space

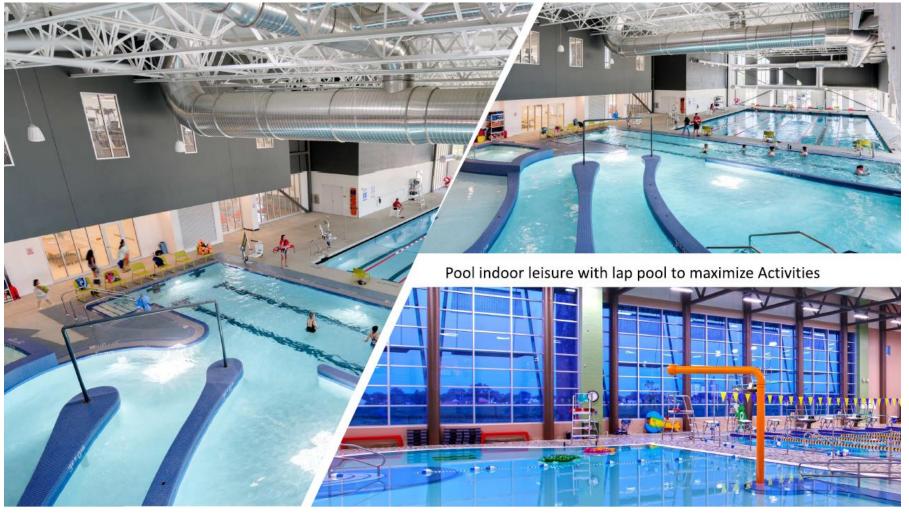

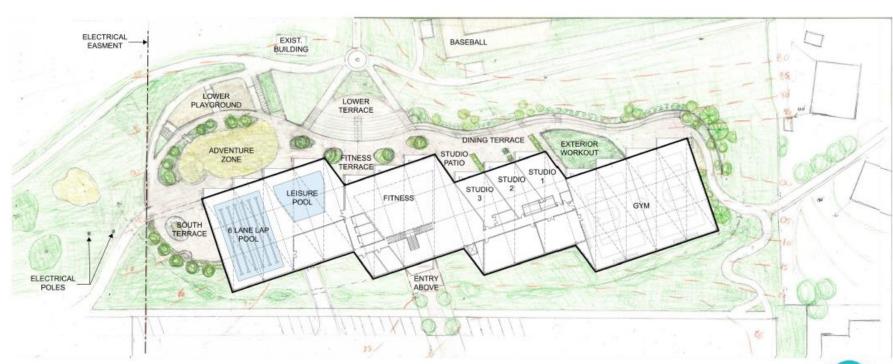
